Environment and Safety Policy

By making available adequate human, instrumental and financial resources, as an integral part of its activity and as a strategic commitment to the Company's general mission, Top Management undertakes to pursue the continuous improvement of management and performance in environmental and energy matters, as well as the safety, prevention and monitoring of accidents, including significant ones, for the protection of human health, environmental resources and assets.

The Senior Management undertakes to ensure that:

- ✓ There must be a constant predisposition and desire for continuous improvement in the management of environmental and safety aspects, as well as, more generally, the protection of the environment and the optimal use of natural resources, safety and the prevention of major accidents, with reference the current situation and the future prospects of the organisation, taking into account context, risks and opportunities;
- ✓ all measures necessary to safeguard the environment and natural resources and to prevent pollution, accidents, injuries and work-related illnesses are constantly implemented;
- ✓ practical training is regularly carried out with the purpose of checking the correct implementation of the operating procedures contained in the internal emergency plan (IEP) for the management of identified accident scenarios;
- ✓ compliance with obligations, legal requirements and other applicable requirements are implemented and maintained over time;
- ✓ all workers are aware of the general commitment of the organisation to the efficacy of the Management System, and to the constant aim for improvement in performance;
- ✓ specific key performance indicators (KPIs) are introduced and a monitoring process is established to measure progress towards continuous improvement, assigning responsibilities to this end;
- ✓ all workers present on site are informed of the major accident risks and the measures in place to prevent them or limit their consequences for human and environmental health;
- \checkmark all workers are consulted, also via their representatives;
- ✓ all workers participate, in accordance with their roles and skills, in the achievement of the designated safety and environmental goals;
- ✓ all workers are trained, informed and made aware of how to carry out their tasks in safe conditions, and how to take responsibility and fulfil their obligations in terms of the Environment and Safety;
- ✓ a system of continuous feedback from workers on training programmes and technical and procedural measures adopted is implemented to enable improvement of operating methods and ensure that emerging needs, risks and opportunities are addressed promptly;
- ✓ all staff involved in the management, use and maintenance of the facilities and warehouses have the necessary awareness of the implications of their activities on the environment, safety, and the prevention of major accidents.



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The Senior Management expresses the conviction that the application of these principles is the basis for guaranteeing increased growth and ensuring that the company is truly competitive on the market. To this end, the organisation aims to:

- constantly verify work methods and operating procedures in order to prevent accidents, including major accidents, and situations of non-compliance with the requirements of the Management System;
- \checkmark apply the Best Technology Available in the construction of new facilities and/or in the event of substantial modifications;
- ✓ reduce the consumption of natural resources and establish systems and processes aimed at improving energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions, with a view to contributing to the fight against climate change and promoting, both in the procurement and design phases, solutions that allow for the improvement of energy performance;
- ✓ implement a programme to monitor the Management System;
- \checkmark ensure and develop effective communication with all staff and workers' representatives;
- \checkmark develop and implement procedures with the purpose of preventing accidents or emergencies and containing their effects;
- \checkmark integrate sustainability aspects into corporate strategies and operations;
- \checkmark maintain open dialogue with suppliers and contractors, obliging them to implement practices that are in line with this policy;
- \checkmark carry out checks, inspections and audits with the purpose of identifying and preventing possible situations of non-compliance with the requirements of the Management System;
- \checkmark develop and maintain collaborative relationships with local authorities and all stakeholders.

Each year, on the occasion of Management Review, the Company will:

- ✓ review the Environment and Safety policy and the entire Management System, to verify its effectiveness and the need for any updates, and to ensure its relevance and adequacy to the nature and extent of the organisation's risks/opportunities;
- \checkmark verify the degree of achievement of objectives and implementation of any action plans;
- ✓ communicate changes, if any, to all persons operating under the direction of the organisation.
